## **SPONSOR A DOG SCHEME**

**We currently have five dogs in need of extra care and attention and would love to have you as a sponsor.**

1. **SANDY** – is a fawn greyhound who had previously raced but sadly he had not received the care and attention he deserved. As a result of not being exercised, Sandy's nails had grown so long that they had become embedded in his pads causing him great pain. Although Sandy's paws have healed, he cannot overcome his fear of being handled and does not realise people only want to help him.
2. **BLACKIE**- is a 3-year-old black lurcher. Blackie finds it extremely difficult to live within a family environment due to his extreme anxiety and nervousness around people he doesn't know. Blackie is now living happily with his foster carers who are aware and able to help Blackie with his special needs.
3. **LADY**- is an 8-year-old black greyhound. Lady has been living with her foster carer for the last 3 years. Lady suffers with an ongoing fungal nail bed infection to three of her feet, the condition of her feet was so bad at one time that she had to have a toe removed from her back right foot. Lady has to have permanent vet nary treatment to stop her feet becoming so bad that she would have to have more toes removed. If Lady didn't have this treatment then she would be in a great deal of pain and would be unable to happily run around like she does.
4. **MACEY** – is an 11-year-old white greyhound. Macey originally came into Grw care 7 years ago after racing, her new adopted owner was unable to continue caring for Macey due to unforeseen family circumstances. Macey is now living with foster carers and their two greyhounds. Because of Macey's age and the possibility of ill health due to her age it is very difficult to find Macey another permanent home. Macey will continue to live happily with her new foster carers for the rest of her life.
5. **STACEY**- is beautiful tan and white greyhound with a beautiful temperament too. Stacey has tendon problems in her front legs and is unable to go for long walks or run around like her lurcher friend does that she lives with. Stacey has to receive continuous medication to help her with the pain in her legs and also supplements to help her with her mobility. Even though Stacey can sometimes feel discomfort from her legs her lovely temperament never changes.
