Thank you for your interest in this post. Successful applicants will be joining Greyhound Rescue Wales (GRW) at a very exciting time in its development. The Registered Charity No:1059733 began its work 24 years ago however six years ago we received of a significant legacy. A working group of volunteers spent a significant amount of time consulting with members as to how this legacy should be spent.

As a result of this consultation in July 2013 GRW purchased a property in Garnant, Ammanford which is now operating as a highly successful Sanctuary, Assessment and Rehoming Centre for greyhounds and lurchers in Wales. The Sanctuary, its systems and processes were set up by Sandra Wynne, GRW's current Sanctuary Manager. It has been very successfully operating since then with an excellent record of the number of dogs rehabilitated and homed. Sandra is moving on to pastures new and the Trustees have taken the decision to not only appoint to the Manager's post, but also to create a new post of Sanctuary Director.
